Dillard is part of a legal team advising Grand Prairie Farms, which is vying for two medical marijuana-growing licenses in Will and Kankakee counties.

Dillard told the Better Government Association he has no financial stake in Grand Prairie Farms, nor does his legal work for the group affect his current role as chairman of the Regional Transportation Authority, the government agency that regulates the CTA, Metra and Pace. The chairman role carries a \$25,000-a-year taxpayer-backed salary and is part-time. The post does not bar outside income such as Dillard's legal work. [Read more](#)
