# Call the Governor to VETO HB 398 Eliminates Happy Hour provision that prevents drunk driving Allows Local Liquor Commissioner to approve alcohol near churches/ schools

HB 398 would allow discounted beer, wine, and spirits to be sold for up to 4 hours a day or 15 hours a week. Happy hour deals would end at 10:00 p.m.

Bars and restaurants would be allowed to serve house-infused spirits, with higher alcohol content.

HB 398 allows Party Packages that include free food and entertainment, include drinks of alcohol as part of a meal package, and include drinks of alcoholic liquor as part of a hotel package.

A new study finds 14 percent of American adults currently have an alcohol use disorder (AUD). The study funded by the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism (NIAAA), reports that nearly one-third of adults in the United States have an AUD at some time in their lives, but only about 20 percent seek treatment. HB 398 allows the sale of more than one drink per person at a time, which was banned in 1989 because of concerns for drunken driving.

HB 398 also allows a local liquor commissioner to make an exemption to approve a liquor license closer than 100 feet from a church or school.
