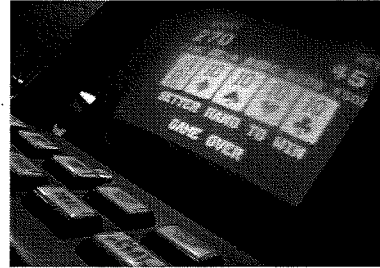

**Gambling Action Alert
Reminder - Important hearing
Tuesday, Jan. 26**



Hearing on 24-hour Bingo Hall (Tribal Casino) in Shabbona

The U.S. Department of Interior Bureau of Indian Affairs has announced that **a public forum, will be held at 6:30 p.m. Jan. 26 at the Kishwaukee College Conference Center, 21193 Malta Road, Malta.** It is a first step in crafting an environmental impact study and an impact statement on the tribe's plans to bring casino gambling to the area.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather comments from the public regarding the scope of the project." said Scott Doig, the bureau's acting regional environmental scientist.

Residents and other stakeholders will have an opportunity to speak at the meeting, and federal representatives will use the information to gauge what benefits or distress the gambling would have on Shabbona and the region.

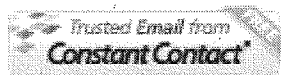
