## A casino to help fund Chicago pensions?

The governor is getting mixed signals from two police groups about a pension bill, the *Chicago Sun-Times* reported. "Police and fire supported the bill because another bill was supposed to be introduced <u>allowing a casino to be built in Chicago</u>. And the casino proceeds would go into the police and fire pensions until they were 90 percent funded," the newsletter from the retired officers' group states. But for some strange reason, Sen. Cullerton sent the bill to the governor for his signature, without a casino bill. Read more

Chicago municipal workers are pitching state lawmakers on proposals to shore up their pension fund by dramatically increasing the amount of taxpayer money going into it, the *Chicago Tribune* reported. Where would the money come from? **A Chicago casino**, which still doesn't exist despite two decades of city efforts. It's the same money machine Emanuel is eyeing for the police and fire pension funds.

Even with a casino, the city would have to cut spending, raise

hundreds of millions of more dollars each year or both to make the contributions required under each of the payment schedules under four different versions of the municipal workers' plan. Read more
