Gambling Legislation

City-owned casino in Chicago: **Oppose**

Additional casinos (Danville, Rockford, Waukegan, South Suburbs of Chicago, Springfield, Williamson County, racetracks): **Oppose**

Expansion of casinos to allow Internet gambling, unlimited progressive jackpots, sports gambling): **Oppose**

Electronic gambling at racetracks (slots/video gambling, electronic table games): **Undecided**

Expansion of the Lottery (Keno, all tickets/scratch offs sold online, making Internet Lottery pilot program permanent, etc): **Oppose**

Charitable gambling expansion (electronic bingo, remote caller bingo, statewide raffles, sweepstake machines, etc): **Oppose**

Video Gambling expansion - increasing maximum bet/jackpots, progressive jackpots, allowing machine owners to own establishments, etc.: **Oppose**
