***Gambling Legislation***

City-owned casino in Chicago: **OPPOSE**

Additional casinos (Danville, Rockford, Waukegan, South Suburbs of Chicago, Springfield, Williamson County, racetracks):  
**OPPOSE**

Expansion of casinos to allow Internet gambling, unlimited progressive jackpots, Sports gambling): **OPPOSE**

Electronic gambling at racetracks (slots/video gambling, table games): **UNDETERMINED, PROBABLY NO**

Expansion of the Lottery (Keno, all tickets/scratch offs sold online, making Internet Lottery pilot program permanent, etc): **OPPOSE**

Charitable gambling expansion (electronic bingo, remote caller bingo, statewide raffles, sweepstake machines, etc): **OPPOSE**

Video Gambling expansion - increasing maximum bid/ jackpots, progressive jackpots, allowing machine owners to own establishments, etc.: **OPPOSE**

Legalizing sports gambling and Internet Fantasy Sports gambling: **OPPOSE**

***Alcohol Regulation***

Approve legislation to allow liquor licenses to be closer than 100 feet from a church or school (currently not allowed): **OPPOSED**

***Drug Legalization***

Extension/expansion of medical marijuana pilot program: **UNDECIDED, MOSTLY OPPOSED**

Legalization of marijuana for "recreational" use: **OPPOSED**

Legalization of all illegal drugs (heroin, cocaine, meth, LSD, etc.): **OPPOSED**

***Comments: Regarding medical marijuana . . . I ask medical professionals for their opinion on this . . . Medical uses for cannabis may have merit. I applaud Gov. Rauner for restricting the immediate expansion of medical cannabis use until further medical testing can be performed.***
